- 5. Members were apprised of the budgeting of funds under State CAMPA under Civil Deposits Sub head of account * 8443- Civil Deposits- 002 - CAMPA-07- Deposits and * 8443 - Civil Deposit-00-109 -Forest Deposits-002-CAMPA -23- withdrawal as approved by the Finance Department, Govt. of West Bengal for parking of funds of State CAMPA.
- The committee was informed that due to opening of a Savings cum Fixed Deposit account (Flexi account) in Union Bank of India, Salt Lake, the Saving Bank account in Union Bank of India was closed.
- 7. Shri Sukanta Kumar Paul, member, proposed that campaign on environment awareness and forest & wildlife protection should be initiated through NGOs. The committee, therefore, decided to earmark Rs 5.0 lakh for this purpose to be allotted to the Divisional Forest Officers in each District. While executing this work the respective DFOs would involve the local NGOs in the District.
- As regards the proposal to enhance the wages of the persons engaged in CAMPA cell through the placement agencies, the committee decided that the issue be resolved administratively.
